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Board Meeting Updates



Since our last update, our board has expanded. We welcome Piers McCleery as the new Deputy Chair of our Board, together with Katie Jackson & Kate Digby, our new Paediatric PPV Board Reps. We also have an Integrated Care Board (ICB) Representative as a regular attendee.

We are focusing on building up our Network Data Dashboard to improve access to data, gain a better understanding of capacity & demand across the network and capture the needs of colleagues and our wider patient population.

So far, we've completed three cycles and emerging themes are becoming clear. Centres complete a quarterly questionnaire with iterative improvements made each cycle. Participation is gradually increasing though some centres face data acquisition challenges we hope to resolve over time .





Joe Eurell shared a quarterly Work Plan update for NHS England. Network Risk Register items remain low and we aim to include quality metrics like compliments and complaints to guide improvements.

Working Group (WG) Updates

Paediatricians with Expertise in Cardiology (PEC)

These meetings are chaired by Dr Tosin Otunla, Ashford & St. Peter's PEC and who is also our Network PEC on our board. We encourage PECs to attend meetings however, engagement remains a challenge with clinical commitments and completing diaries. To improve engagement, we rotate meeting days and times. The fixed Wednesday afternoon slot for cross-site MDMs also often conflicts with prior commitments. Nonetheless, the group is working on Network Guidelines, focusing on discharge and referrals to support PECs in local clinics. They have also contributed ideas for the agenda of the upcoming virtual Network meeting.



Feedback from first PEC education session

The first session was on 'Image Optimisation' was a huge success. We had 24 attendees and received feedback from 16. The session was highly valued for its friendly atmosphere, clear explanations, and practical focus on image optimization. The attendees appreciated:

- Learning useful and applicable tips for echo and image acquisition, such as optimizing compression and gain settings for coronary artery imaging.
- Insights into techniques like focusing during colour Doppler and compression adjustments, which were described as impactful and easy to apply in practice.
- The well-paced teaching, concise information, and lack of overemphasis on physics.
- Having relevant slides and echo examples provided after the session.

Overall, it was considered refreshing, well-structured and delivered at the right level of detail for its audience.
